Trust Update

On Monday 18th March it was confirmed that Deanery and Kingfisher will move to the Park Academies Trust. For the schools in Swindon and Wiltshire, the period of time for Trusts to express a formal expression of interest in the schools, opened on Monday 18th March and will close on 5th April. The DFE will then hold discussions with the Trusts that have expressed an interest.

Class Structure for Sep 2024-25

As a school we have experienced a falling role for several years. We are now at 162 pupils and our capacity is 210. We have had to make the decision to move to a six-class structure for September 2024 with some mixed age classes, as the school cannot financially sustain a seven class structure. I cannot share what the mix of the classes will be at present as I will need to wait until the end of April for confirmed numbers for our Reception Class. I will be able to make the decision in early May and I will communicate with you then the design of the six classes.

On Wednesday we were able to visit the church as a school and Reverend Phil led our Church Service. It was lovely to be able to do this again and for Reception this was the first time they had been able to visit. We really appreciated Reverend Phil making time for us at such a busy time of year for him.
