

Reading

Children will either continue engaging with the RWI phonics programme to support and strengthen their early reading skills or take part in guided reading sessions.

Writing

This term, children will be exploring the traditional fairy tale Hansel and Gretel. They will develop their reading, speaking, and writing skills by retelling the story, focusing on key events, characters and story language. As part of their writing, the children will also be creating a set of instructions to help Hansel and Gretel find their way safely back home.



Mathematics

Year 1: Will be developing their number knowledge and counting skills. We will begin by counting, recognising and comparing numbers from 0–10. As the term progresses, we will move on to counting forwards and backwards to and from 20, before exploring how to count in tens.

Year 2: Will begin by exploring multiples of 10 and learning to represent numbers from 20 – 99. We will then move on to calculating within 20, using a variety of strategies to solve addition and subtraction problems.

PSHE

Being Me in My World: This term, the children will explore what helps them feel safe, special and calm in their class.

Art

The children will be creating their own Tree Boggarts. Using clay, they will press and shape their designs onto tree trunks, sculpting imaginative faces and characters. They will then use natural materials to add texture and detail to their creations.

Science

The children will be learning about different types of trees and exploring the question: Deciduous or Evergreen?

Computing

In computing, the children will be learning about Computing Systems and Networks. As part of this unit, the children will also learn important online safety skills to help them use technology safely and responsibly.

Geography

This term in Geography, the children will be learning how to draw and read simple picture maps. They will develop their understanding of maps by using symbols and pictures to represent places and features in their local environment.
