

## Reading

This term in reading, children will either be learning phonics through the Read Write Inc. Programme or taking part in guided reading sessions to develop their comprehension, fluency and confidence as readers. Our first guided reading text will be *The Bear and the Piano*.

## Writing

In English, we will be working with the story *One day on Our Blue Planet: In the Outback*. The children will rewrite the story using a different outback animal of their choice, and their non-fiction writing will focus on creating a postcard from Australia.



## Mathematics

### Year 1:

Our focus this term will be addition and subtraction, including learning addition and subtraction facts within 10.

### Year 2:

We will be introduced to division structures. Discussing and comparing 2D and 3D shapes. Then starting our unit on addition and subtraction of two-digit numbers.

## Computing

We will be learning all about pictograms, exploring how information can be collected, organised and presented using simple charts and symbols.

## PE

Our focus in PE this term will be archery and orienteering. Our PE days are Tuesdays and Thursdays.

## Science

## Geography
