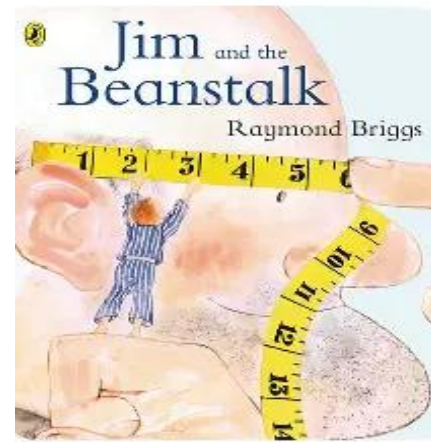


Reading

This term in reading, children will either be learning phonics through the Read Write Inc. Programme or taking part in guided reading sessions to develop their comprehension, fluency and confidence as readers. Our first guided reading text will be *The Tin Forest*.

Writing

In English, we will be working with the story *Jim and the Beanstalk*. At the beginning of the term, the children will be writing a character description. We will then move on to a non-fiction writing outcome which will focus on writing a letter to persuade.



Mathematics

Year 1: The children will be learning about the *composition of numbers from 11 to 19* and working with *numbers 0–20 in meaningful contexts*. They will also begin a new unit on *unitising and coin recognition*, helping them understand how numbers can be grouped and how different coins represent value.

Year 2: The children will be continuing to look at *adding and subtracting two-digit numbers*. We will then move on to our unit on *money*, where they will be recognising different coins and learning to use the £ and p symbols accurately.

Design Technology

In DT this term, the children will be working on *mechanisms* by designing and making their own moving aliens.

PSHE

This term in PSHE, we will be learning about relationships. Looking at how to build positive connections, understand feelings and communicate kindly and confidently with others.

Computing

The children will be learning about *programming quizzes*. Exploring how simple programmes work and designing their own quiz questions.

Science

This term, our science topic will focus on *Plants: Growth and Care*. The children will be exploring what plants need to grow, how to look after them, and why they are important in our world.

Music

We will be exploring how music makes us feel happy. The children will be thinking about how different sounds, rhythms and instruments affect our feelings.

RE

The children will be exploring the question *“How do different people find deeper meanings?”* They’ll look at a range of beliefs, practices, and life experiences to understand how individuals and communities make sense of the world around them.

PE

Our focus in PE this term will be Tennis and Rounders. Our PE days are Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Geography

We will be learning about *seasonal and daily weather patterns*. We will explore how weather changes throughout the year, how we observe and describe different types of weather, and why these patterns matter in our everyday lives.
