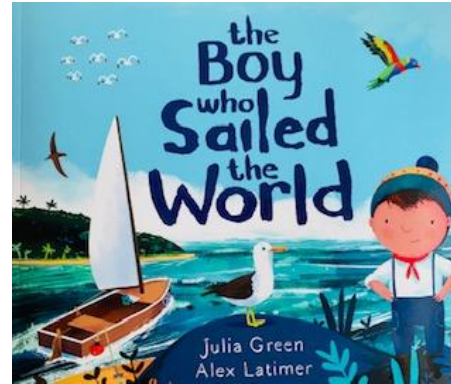


Reading

Children will either continue engaging with the RWI phonics programme to support and strengthen their early reading skills or take part in guided reading sessions. Their first guided reading text will be the *National Geographic: Titanic* book.

Writing

In English, we will be working with the story *The Boy who Sailed the World*. They children will be rewriting the middle of the story, sending the boy on an exciting new adventure. For their non-fiction outcome, they will be writing a diary entry from the boy's perspective, exploring his thoughts and feelings as he travels.



Mathematics

Year 1: This term, the children will be recognising and using coins, describing position and direction, and telling the time to the hour and half-hour. They will be applying these skills through practical activities to build confidence and fluency.

Year 2: Their learning will focus on fractions, telling the time and different types of measure. They will develop confidence working with halves, quarters and thirds, practise reading clocks to the nearest 5 minutes, and explore measuring length, weight and capacity through practical problem-solving activities.

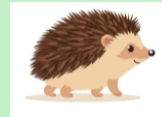
History

We will be exploring the sinking of the Titanic in history, learning what happened and why this event remains such a significant moment in the past.

PSHE

This term in PSHE, the children will be learning about *Changing Me*. They will be exploring how we grow and change, developing confidence, and understanding how to look after themselves as they continue to grow.

PE

Our focus in PE this term will be Athletics and Handball. Our PE days are Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Computing

The children will be learning about *robot algorithms*. Exploring how to give clear, step-by-step instructions for a robot to follow.

RE

The children will be learning about different places of worship in RE and exploring what makes these spaces sacred and special to the people who use them.

Art

In art this term, the children will be exploring *Painting and Mixed Media: Life in Colour*. They'll experiment with colour, texture and different materials to express ideas and create vibrant, imaginative artwork.

Science

This term, our science topic will focus on how humans and other animals change as they develop, and what living things need to grow healthily.

Music

This term, the children will be exploring *improvisation* in music and thinking about the big question: *How does music teach us about looking after our planet?* They'll experiment with creating their own musical ideas while learning how music can inspire care for the world around us.
