

## Reading

This term in reading, children will be learning spelling through the Read Write Inc. Programme and also taking part in guided reading sessions to develop their comprehension, fluency and confidence as readers. Our first text is *The Wild Robot*.

## Design Technology

In DT this term, the children will have experience sewing to join fabrics *together to make a book sleeve*.

## Music

The Year 4s will be continue to learn the Ukulele by specialist music teacher. The Year 3s will practice the recorder and compose songs.

## Writing

In English, we will be working with the story *Sulwe*. At the beginning of the term, the children will be writing a fable and then moving onto a non-fiction writing outcome which will focus on writing a letter to persuade.

## Term 5 Who was Julius Caesar?



## PSHE

This term in PSHE, we will be learning about relationships. Looking at how to build positive and healthy relationships - understand feelings why people are special to them.

## RE

The children will be exploring the theme – Rites of Passage- and our BIG QUESTION “*How do communities mark growing up?*” They’ll look at a range of beliefs, practices, and life experiences to understand how individuals and communities make sense of the world around them as the develop into adults.

## Mathematics

**Year 3:** The children will be learning the 2, 4 and 8 times tables and using the times tables to solve problems in context. They will also begin new units on column subtraction and understanding unit fractions as part of whole.

**Year 4:** The children will continue to practise their times tables as part of getting ready for the Multiplication Test. We will then move on to our units on *coordinates*, a review of fractions and composition of fractions greater than one.

## Computing

This term, we will look at repetition and loops within programming. Pupils will create programs by planning, modifying, and testing commands to create shapes and patterns.

## PE

Our focus in PE this term will be Cricket and Swimming. Our PE days are Mondays and (Fridays - Swimming).

## Science

This term, our science topic will focus on *Sound*: identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating; recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear.

## History Ancient Rome

What happened when the Romans came to Britain? This will include Julius Caesar’s attempted invasion in 55-54 BC. Children will extend their learning to look at the impact this had on Britain.
